### **READ**

Isaiah 53:3-6

<sup>3</sup> He was despised and rejected by mankind,  
a man of suffering, and familiar with pain.  
Like one from whom people hide their faces  
He was despised, and we held Him in low esteem.

<sup>4</sup> Surely He took up our pain  
and bore our suffering,  
yet we considered Him punished by God,  
stricken by Him, and afflicted.

<sup>5</sup> But He was pierced for our transgressions,  
He was crushed for our iniquities;  
the punishment that brought us peace was on Him,  
and by His wounds we are healed.

<sup>6</sup> We all, like sheep, have gone astray,  
each of us has turned to our own way;  
and the LORD has laid on Him  
the iniquity of us all.

*These verses, written hundreds of years before Jesus' birth, prophesied about the suffering of the Messiah and what He would have to bear for the sin of man.*

- What stood out for you as you read these verses?
- In what ways have we gone astray in our lives?
- How do these verses help you understand the seriousness of sin and the depth of God's love for us?

## **DISCUSS**

- Who in your life needs to hear the message of the cross? Share 1 or 2 names.
- Our church is believing to see 153 lives come to know the Lord this year. Would you be part of it? What is one practical step you can take to lead a pre-believer closer to the Lord this year?
