SERMON RECAP

Through stories of revival, real-life examples like Doris Lim and Jesus' own teachings, we are called to see evangelism as more than a task.

1. Evangelism is More than a Task; It's a Lifestyle (Matt 5:14-16)
 - Evangelism should be a lifestyle; not a hidden identity.
 - Evangelism begins with how we live, not just how we share the gospel.
 - When our lifestyle is light of the world, we become a testimony of Jesus to everyone around us.
2. Evangelism is More than a Task; It's a Privilege (2 Cor 5:20)
 - Sometimes we see evangelism as a task, as doing God a favour.
 - Even though God does not need us, God chooses to **partner** with us to accomplish His saving work.
 - As ambassadors of Christ, we have been given this special privilege to represent Christ and point people to Him.
 - Do you feel privileged to be part of your Father's business?

3. Evangelism is More than a Task; It's GOD's Heart (Luke 15)
 - God's heart is for the lost. God wants disciples who share His heart for the lost and share in His joy when sinners are restored.
 - God spared no expense for the lost that He gave His only begotten Son to die on the cross to redeem them.

1. Which of the three points (Lifestyle, Privilege, or God's Heart) speaks to you most, and why?
2. How can we make evangelism part of our everyday lives?
3. What are your fears or barriers to sharing the gospel? How can we overcome them together?
