SERMON RECAP

John 13:34-35 *"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."*

What does it mean for a community of believers to love one another as Christ loved them? And what effect does it have on the world?

1. The Motivation - Living On God's Love

- We need a life-consuming experience of God's love for us and understand how much He loves us, or we will be ill-equipped to love as Christ loved us.

2. The Model - Living Out God's Love

- Jesus was the model of love which the disciples were to follow.
- Jesus gave the disciples an example of love by washing their feet. It was a call for the disciples (and likewise for us) to love each other in humility and selflessness in deeds and actions.

3. The Message - Living to Make God's Love Tangible

- The love that we have for one another will testify about Jesus to others.
- God's love is brought to full expression in our lives when we love one another. Through our acts of love within the church body, God's love becomes a tangible reality that is experienced by others (1 John 4:12).

SHARING

1. In light of Jesus' command to "love one another as I have loved you," how have you seen this kind of love demonstrated in our church community?
2. When have you found it difficult to love those around you?
3. What steps can we take to better reflect Jesus' humility and selflessness in our cell, church, and daily life?

- Pray that our love for one another will reflect Christ and allow others to experience God's love tangibly.
- Continue to pray for Cindy Chua (SP's wife)
